

Extended Care



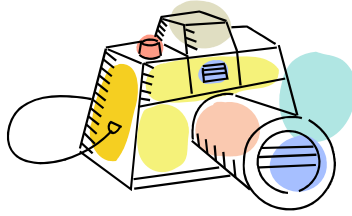
Welcome to fall in the extended care classroom!
