City University Athens

Students live and study in the shadow of the ancient Acropolis while participating in BCA's program in Athens. Field trips to such places as Delphi, Corinth, Mycenae, Epidaurus, Naphleon, and Sparta provide students with an introduction to the history and culture of Greece.

Courses available in Mass Media, Marketing, and Public Relations.

China Studies Program

Students study Chinese language, culture, and society and take part in two-week service projects.

In addition to meeting cross-cultural requirements, students earn non-western studies credits and can take a course in Intercultural Communications.

Daystar University

Messiah students can join the approximately 1,800 learners who study each year at Daystar University in Kenya, East Africa. Daystar offers students a semester (or year-long) experience forty miles from Nairobi at the Athi River Campus.

Internships

London Internship Program

The London Internship Program offers internships and academic study for a semester in London, England. Students are placed in field experiences related to their majors and take classes offered by Arcadia faculty or at City University.

Philadelphia Campus

Studying in Philadelphia allows students to have the benefits of a large university and the closeness of a small community as they experience an urban culture.

University of Gloucestershire
