Daystar University

Messiah students can join the approximately 1,800 learners who study each year at Daystar University in Kenya, East Africa. Daystar offers students a semester or a year-long experience forty miles from Nairobi at the Athi River Campus.

- ✓ 2.75 GPA

BCA programs in Ecuador, France, Germany, and Spain, allow students to enhance their language skills by studying at a university in another country where courses are taught in the host country's language.

- ✓ Junior or senior status
- ✓ Four semesters of college-level language for France and Germany (Five semesters is required for Spain.)
- ✓ 3.0 GPA.

Note: Education majors may want to browse department sheets from other disciplines to explore programs that may offer courses in their academic concentrations.

Philadelphia Campus

Studying at the Philadelphia Campus allows students to have the benefits of a large university and the closeness of a small community as they experience an urban culture.

- ✓Sophomore, junior, or senior status
- ✓2.25 GPA

*Students can choose to participate in the **Urban Semester Program** which offers an opportunity for students to earn general education credits while they study urban culture and issues. This is a nice option for students choosing a multi-cultural / urban studies minor.*

Service-Learning

This year-long program, open to all majors, will give students an opportunity to integrate faith and learning, fulfilling the college-wide educational objective of preparing students to act as servants in the world.

- ✓First year, sophomore, or junior status

The program is broken into three sequential components: a spring preparatory class, a summer service experience, and a reflective fall course.

Student Visitor Program

- ✓First year through senior year
- ✓Good academic standing

Students can study at any of the 12 schools that make up the Christian College Consortium.

University of Gloucestershire

Located in southwestern England (near the border of Wales). University of Gloucestershire is home to the BCA program in the UK. Messiah student experience British life in the quaint English town of Cheltenham. Students also travel to historical and cultural locations around the country.

- ✓Sophomore, junior, or senior status
- ✓2.7 GPA.

The University of Gloucestershire allows students the option of studying and experiencing the British educational system by participating in a field experience in a British school. The university also offers courses in Early Childhood Studies and Education and Learning.
