City University Athens

Students live and study in the shadow of the ancient Acropolis while participating in BCA's program in Athens. Field trips to such places as Delphi, Corinth, Mycenae, Epidaurus, Naphleon, and Sparta provide students with an introduction to the history and culture of Greece.

Creation Care Study Program

This semester-long program explores biblical Stewardship, first hand, in *New Zealand/Samoa*.

Meets a number of general education requirements, including laboratory science, Bible, Christian beliefs, social science, non-western, and cross-cultural requirements.

Daystar University

Messiah students can join the approximately 1,800 learners who study each year at Daystar University in Kenya, East Africa.

The university offers courses that may fulfill general education requirements. Participation in the program will fulfill cross cultural requirement.

Philadelphia Campus

Studying at Philadelphia allows students to have the benefits of a large university and the closeness of a small community as they experience an urban culture. Students take classes from both Messiah and Temple faculty and live in one of the Messiah-owned buildings on Broad Street.

Engineering courses are available from Temple University.

Service-Learning

The program is broken into three sequential components: a spring preparatory class, a summer service experience, and a reflective fall course.

Students can study at any of the schools that make up the Christian College Consortium for a semester without the hassle of exhaustive application forms, putting the educational resources of 12 other colleges at their disposal.

University of Gloucestershire

Located in southwestern England (near the border of Wales). University of Gloucestershire is home to the BCA program in the UK. Messiah students experience British life in the quaint English town of Cheltenham. Students also travel to historical and cultural locations around the country.

University of San Francisco of Quito

Quito, often referred to as the "land of eternal spring," provides Messiah students with a beautiful location to work on their language skills. Students study in a South American university, live with Ecuadorian families, and travel to the Amazon rain forest and the Galapagos Islands.

✓Four semesters of college-level Spanish are required

NOTE: The only time Engineering majors can participate in semester-long off-campus programs is during the first (fall) semester of their sophomore years.
