LCC International University

Witness history in the making while studying in Klaipeda, Lithuania. LCC International University serves students from a number of Eastern European nations. Students take educational excursions to Latvia, Estonia, and Russia.

Classes have included World Literature, Structure of Language, Language Research Methods, Journalistic Writing, Writing Poetry, Short Fiction, and Drama.

London Internship Program

The London Internship Program offers internships and academic study for a semester in London, England. Students are placed in field experiences related to their majors and take classes offered by Arcadia faculty or at City University.

Oregon Extension

Each fall, the Oregon Extension welcomes 40 students to a rustic setting in the Cascade Mountains, where serious students can ask their deepest questions, read gripping and challenging books, and wrestle with profound ideas in writing

Courses include Literary Perspectives on Modern Society, Literary perspectives on the Human Condition, Religion and faith in Literary Perspectives, and Composition and Rhetoric.

The Orvieto Semester (Italy)

The landscape of pre-modern Italy, populated by saints, mystics, artists, and poets, provides a foundation for this semester in Orvieto. Students examine these traces of Western classical civilization, exploring its relationship with present-day European culture.

Available courses include Creative Writing, Dante, and Shakespeare in Italy.

Philadelphia Campus

Studying in Philadelphia allows students to have the benefits of a large university and the closeness of a small community as they experience an urban culture.

Students can choose from a variety of education, journalism, literature, and writing courses.

Scholars' Semester in Oxford

Taste a slice of British life and experience the unique Oxford educational system by participating in the Scholars' Semester in Oxford. Academically strong students participate in one-on-one tutorials with Oxford professors, as well as take part in a variety of field trips.

Uganda Studies Program

Students will explore African culture, live in dorms with East African students, and participate in service projects in orphanages and medical clinics. During the semester students will travel to historic sites, parks and cities within the country.

Courses have included Contemporary African Literature, Literature of the Bible and Christian Classics, and Poetic Map of Africa.

University of Gloucestershire

Located in southwestern England (near the border of Wales). University of Gloucestershire is home to the BCA program in the UK. Messiah students experience British life in the quaint English town of Cheltenham. Students also travel to historical and cultural locations around the country.

The university offers a variety of literature and writing courses.

Washington Journalism Center

Students will develop hard-news writing skills, study the history and future of Washington, and examine the role of Christians in the media. A WJC internship class provides students with mentoring and supervision during their mainstream newsroom experiences.
