Although EpiCenter programs are open to all students, there are some programs that may be of particular interest to students in the Department of Human Development and Family Studies. Below is a description of these opportunities. For more details, stop by the EpiCenter.

City University Athens

Students live and study in the shadow of the ancient Acropolis while participating in BCA's program in Athens. Field trips to such places as Delphi, Corinth, Mycenae, Epidaurus, Naphleon, and Sparta provide students with an introduction to the history and culture of Greece.

Creation Care Study Program

The mountainous islands of New Zealand provide an ideal setting for students to explore environmental stewardship. New Zealand shelters 12 % of the world's endangered species; the country actively engages in conservation efforts and promotes ecological awareness. Through trips to various regions of New Zealand, you will be able to witness your course material firsthand!

Students can fulfill a number of general education requirements, including Science, Technology and the World, Lab Science, Christian beliefs, non-western, and cross-cultural requirements.

Internships

Students have an opportunity to test their theories in real world settings as they preview possible career opportunities. The program is specifically designed to help students gain an awareness of the demands and issues within a particular profession and consider how values and faith apply to the work place.

LCC International University

Witness history in the making while studying in Klaipeda, Lithuania. Part of the former Soviet Union, Lithuania is home to LCC International University which serves students from a number of Eastern European nations.

Philadelphia Campus

Studying at Philadelphia allows students to have the benefits of a large university and the closeness of a small community as they experience an urban culture.

Scholars' Semester in Oxford

Taste a slice of British life and experience the unique Oxford educational system by participating in the Scholars' Semester in Oxford. Academically strong students participate in one-on-one tutorials with Oxford professors, as well as take part in a variety of field trips.

Spring Semester in Thailand

Students study Thai language and culture by immersing themselves in a unique Asian experience. Home stays, internship / service projects, travel, and classroom instruction at Chiang Mai University are designed to give students a comprehensive view of life in Thailand. Students take a ten-day field trip to Lanpang, Sukhothai, Phitsanulok, Ayutthaya, Pattaya, and Bangkok.

University of Barcelona

University of Strasbourg

BCA programs in Spain and France allow students to enhance their language skills by studying at a university in another country where courses are taught in the host country's language.

- ✓ Four semesters of college-level language for France; five semesters is required for Spain.
- ✓ 3.0 GPA.

These schools offer behavioral science-related courses.

University of Gloucestershire

Located in southwestern England (near the border of Wales). University of Gloucestershire is home to the BCA program in the UK. Messiah students experience British life in the quaint English town of Cheltenham. Students also travel to historical and cultural locations around the country.

Courses available in Child Care Practices, Early Childhood Studies, Psychology, and Sociology, and Social Work.
