***Creation Care Study Program***

This semester-long program explores biblical stewardship, first hand, in New Zealand/Samoa.

*Explore biblical stewardship while fulfilling a number of general education requirements, including Christian beliefs, social science, non-western, and cross-cultural requirements.*

***Internships***

Students test their educational theories in real world settings as they preview possible career opportunities.

***National Outdoor Leadership School (NOLS)***

This hands-on wilderness education program teaches students "outdoor skills, leadership and environmental ethics" in a variety of locations throughout the U.S.

*Programs in the US take place in the Rockies, Teton Valley, Pacific Northwest, and the Southwest; students can also take part in the Outdoor Educator Semester.*

### ***Philadelphia Campus***

Studying at Philadelphia allows students to have the benefits of a large university and the closeness of a small community as they experience an urban culture. Students take classes from both Messiah and Temple faculty and live in one of the seven Messiah-owned buildings on Broad Street.

### ***University of Gloucestershire***
