American Studies Program

In addition to learning about current issues, students participate in part-time internships in Washington D.C.

BCA

BCA offers students who are seriously interested in enriching their college experiences an opportunity to enhance their curriculum and language skills with a semester or year of study abroad.

- ✓ Sophomore, junior, or senior status
- ✓ Four semesters of college-level language are required for Ecuador, France, Germany, and Mexico (five semesters required for Spain); these sites are open only to juniors and seniors
- ✓ 2.7 GPA (*France, Germany, Mexico, Spain: 3.0 GPA*)

All of the BCA programs, except those in Dalian, China and Sapporo, Japan (which are intensive language programs), offer students a variety of history courses.

China Studies Program

Students will learn Chinese language, history, and culture through classroom instruction, by traveling around the country, and by being conversation partners with Chinese students.

Internships

Students who participate in the Messiah College Internship Program have opportunities to test their educational theories as they preview possible career options.

LCC International University

Witness history in the making while studying in Klaipeda, Lithuania. Part of the former Soviet Union, Lithuania is home to LCC International University which serves students from a number of Eastern European nations.

Students can take classes such as Baltic History, European History, and Western Civilization.

Middle East Studies Program

Students spend a semester in Cairo, Egypt, learning Arabic, studying Middle Eastern culture and religion, and exploring political conflicts. The 15-week adventure includes a field service project and educational excursions to the Israel and several Middle Eastern countries.

This program is ideal for someone interested in history of the Middle East and / or Islamic studies.

Russian Studies Program

Students will visit museums, monasteries, and government institutions in Moscow, experience the Russian heartland in Nizhni Novgorod, and are exposed to the cultural and historical richness of St. Petersburg.

Students can complete their whole language requirement as well as fulfill world views and European history.

Scholars' Semester in Oxford

Taste a slice of British life and experience the unique Oxford educational system by participating in the Scholars' Semester in Oxford. Academically strong students participate in one-on-one tutorials with Oxford professors, as well as take part in a variety of field trips.
