American Studies Program

A semester in our nation's capital will give Messiah College students a first-hand taste of how our government works. In addition to learning about current issues in policy modules, students will participate in part-time internships; business-related internships are available.

- ✓2.75 GPA

A new business track will allow students to explore topics in leadership and management.

BCA

BCA provides students who are seriously interested in enriching their college experiences an opportunity to enhance their curriculum with a semester or year of study abroad.

- ✓Sophomore, junior, or senior status
- ✓2.7 GPA.
- ✓At least four semesters of college-level language are required in Spain, France, Germany, and Mexico; these sites are open only to juniors and seniors (3.0 GPA required for these locations)

Programs in China, England, France, Germany, Greece, Japan, and Spain offer a variety of accounting, business, and economics courses. Students studying with BCA in China may take classes from Dongbei University of Finance and Economics.

China Studies Program

Students are exposed to a country whose people make up a fifth of the world's population. Students will learn Chinese language, history, and culture and can choose a business concentration.

- ✓2.75 GPA

Courses include: "Intercultural Communication" "International Business in China," and "Business Internship."

Contemporary Music Program

Students interested in contemporary music will discover firsthand the inside workings of the music industry. The program offers opportunities for students interested in music management. Students will create and market a CD.

Courses include: "Inside the Music Industry," "Artist Management," and "Music Marketing and Sales."

HRM 352 Human Resource Management in The Netherlands

Students will travel to The Netherlands where Messiah has a partnership with a Dutch Christian college, Christelike Hogeschool Ede. Students visit business and cultural sites and work on a team project with Dutch students. Offered every other January, the course meets a cross-cultural requirement.

Daystar University

Messiah Students can join the approximately 1,800 learners who study each year at Daystar University in Kenya.

- ✓ 2.75 GPA (*The college offers courses in accounting, as well as business and management*).

International Business Institute

Austria, England, Czech Republic, Finland, France, Germany, Russia, Sweden, Switzerland, and The Netherlands are the classroom settings for students who participate in this 10-week adventure. Students experience European historical and cultural interests, listen to briefings by world economic leaders, and take four academic courses.

- ✓ Completed 1 year of economics
- ✓ 2.75 GPA
- ✓ Completed 1 semester each of accounting, marketing, and management

Latin American Studies Program

Students study Latin American economics, culture, politics, and faith when they travel to Costa Rica for 17 weeks of travel, study, and service.

- ✓ Junior or senior status
- ✓ Two semesters of college-level Spanish
- ✓ 2.75 GPA

Students may choose a concentration in International Business and Marketing during the Fall semester in which the service project is replaced by an internship.

LCC International University

Witness history in the making while studying in Klaipeda, Lithuania. Part of the former Soviet Union, Lithuania is home to LCC International University which serves students from a number of Eastern European nations.

- ✓ Sophomore, junior, or senior status
- ✓ 2.5 GPA

Courses available in accounting, business, economics, and marketing.

Russian Studies Program

Students study Russian language, culture, and society and take part in a two-week service projects in Russian churches, community organizations, businesses, or schools during the 15-week program.

- ✓ Junior or senior status
- ✓ 2.75 GPA

Students who choose the four-credit language option will be enrolled in “Russian Business and International Relations.”

The following programs will meet the “Developing Country Experience” for International Business majors: China Studies Program, specific Cross Cultural Courses, as well as BCA (Ecuador, China, Mexico), Central American Study and Service, Daystar, Latin American Studies Program, LCC International University, Middle East Studies Program, Spring Semester in Thailand, Russian Studies Program, Service-Learning (depending on service project), and Uganda Studies Program.
