Australia Studies Centre

Adventure, academics and art! The Sidney-based Wesley Institute provides students with an opportunity to live in this coastal city, to experience Australian culture, and to study visual, theatrical, and musical arts. Students travel to the Blue Mountains, Jenolan Caves, and to the capital city of Canberra.

BCA

BCA offers students who are seriously interested in enriching their college experiences opportunities to enhance their curriculum and language skills with a semester or year of study abroad.
