Dinesh D'Souza has been called one of the "top young public-policy makers in the country" by *Investor's Business Daily*. The *New York Times Magazine* named him one of America's most influential conservative thinkers. The World Affairs Council lists him as one of the nation's 500 leading authorities on international issues.

A former policy analyst in the Reagan White House, D'Souza also served as the John M. Olin Fellow at the American Enterprise Institute, and the Robert and Karen Rishwain Fellow at the Hoover Institution at Stanford University. He graduated Phi Beta Kappa from Dartmouth College in 1983.

D'Souza's books have had a major influence on public opinion and public policy. His 1991 book *Illiberal Education* was the first study to publicize the phenomenon of political correctness. The book was widely acclaimed and became a *New York Times* bestseller. It has been listed as one of the most influential books of the 1990's. In 2002 he published the *New York Times* bestseller *What's So Great About America*, which was critically acclaimed for its thoughtful patriotism. His 2003 book *Letters to a Young Conservative* has become a handbook for a new generation of young conservatives inspired by D'Souza's style and ideas. D'Souza's new book, *What's So Great About Christianity*, is a comprehensive answer to work denouncing theism in general and Christianity in particular.

D'Souza's articles have appeared in the *New York Times*, *Wall Street Journal*, *The Atlantic Monthly*, *Vanity Fair*, *New Republic*, and *National Review*. He has appeared on numerous television programs, including the *Today Show*, *Nightline*, *The News Hour*, *O'Reilly Factor*, *Moneyline*, and *Hannity and Colmes*.
