Dear Students and Parents:

**Hepatitis B is 100 times more contagious than HIV.** The virus attacks the liver and is spread mainly through direct contact with blood or other bodily fluids or through sexual contact. The good news is that it is preventable with a safe and effective vaccine.

The American College Health Association, along with the Center for Disease control (CDC), recommends the vaccine for all non-immunized college students. It consists of a series of three injections given over a period of six months. The Engle Center for Counseling and Health Services provides the vaccine at fair market price.

**Don't take a risk.** Serum will be ordered after payment has been received. The cost of the series cost varies based on age: Adolescent students (19 or younger) incur a lesser cost than for the series than those who are 20 or older. Injections will be given during normal business hours of Monday through Friday 8 AM to 5 PM.

Pricing for the current academic year will be posted after August 15th. Purchasing all three doses at the adolescent cost, requires that all three doses be concluded, prior to the 20th birthday and given in a six month period as prescribed. Dosages may be ordered upon arrival to campus on August 30th. Prepayment of all three doses through Engle Center should be made at the time of ordering.
