DIRECTOR



Geof Weisenborn enters his sixth season as the head men's lacrosse coach at Messiah College. Weisenborn has guided the Falcons to a 48-32 record over the past five years. He has also led the team to the MAC Championship Game three times.

Prior to his appointment at Messiah, Weisenborn spent three years as the head coach at Francis Scott Key High School in Carroll County, Md. Weisenborn also spent two years at Michigan State University as the defensive coordinator in 1999 and as the club's head coach in 2000. Weisenborn is very familiar with the Messiah men's lacrosse program, having spent three years (1998, 2001, 2002) as an assistant coach. During his stint as defensive coordinator at Messiah, Weisenborn helped lead the Falcons to a 31-13 record in three seasons, including the squad's first Middle Atlantic Conference championship and berth to the NCAA tournament in 2001. Coaching the defense, Weisenborn drew on his experience as a four-year starting defenseman at the University of Maryland Baltimore County.

Weisenborn is just the second head coach in the team's 14-year history. The Falcon men's lacrosse program has accumulated a 137-78 record and two tournament bids to the NCAA playoffs since it began in 1997. Weisenborn resides in Gettysburg, Pa., with his wife and two children.

Most of the camp staff will consist of current or former Messiah College coaches and players. Many of the staff have decorated playing careers that include All-American and All-Conference honors. All of our staff members are passionate about the game of lacrosse and are committed to the highest moral and ethical standards.

Sunday, June 26 – Thursday, June 30 (entering grades 6-12)

The Messiah Boys' Lacrosse Camp was developed to give young lacrosse players an opportunity to play together and fully develop through personalized instruction. Messiah lacrosse camp is for players of all levels entering grades 6-12.

During the day, each camper will have three lacrosse sessions a day, along with meals and free time. During free time, there will be swimming, games and a visit to the snack bar. The sessions will include drills, game tactics and scrimmaging. Players at all levels will find a challenging level of lacrosse, catered to their age and experience level. All meals and lodging will be provided by Messiah College.

MESSIAH BOYS' LACROSSE DAY CAMP

Monday, June 27 – Thursday, June 30 (Entering Grades 1-6)

The Messiah Boys' Lacrosse Day Camp was developed to give beginning lacrosse players an opportunity to learn the sport and develop their skills through personalized instruction. The day camp is recommended for beginning players entering 1st-6th grades.

During the camp, each camper will have two sessions a day along with lunch and free time. The morning sessions will focus on individual skills, while the afternoon session

will build up to group concepts. The camp will run from 9 a.m. – 4:30 p.m. Campers will need to bring their own equipment.

MESSIAH GOALIE AND SHOOTING SCHOOL

Saturday, July 9

The Messiah Lacrosse Goalie and Shooting School is a day camp designed to instruct both goalies and offensive players of all levels. The school is divided into two camps to give the individual attention needed to both the goalies and offensive players to improve their skills. Each player will receive individual instruction and numerous repetitions to enforce the newly learned techniques. The final segment will bring both camps together and put the shooters and goalies in live situations against each other to practice their new skills.

GOALIE AND SHOOTING SCHOOL FEE: \$100

MESSIAH COLLEGE PREP CAMP

Thursday, July 28 – Saturday, July 30 (rising juniors and seniors)

The Messiah College Prep Camp is meant to be a high-level teaching and training camp for juniors and seniors (athletes entering their junior or senior year as of fall 2011) planning to play lacrosse at the intercollegiate level. The camp places considerable emphasis on teaching the fundamental playing skills that are needed to succeed in college. The camp is designed to expose high-level players to collegiate concepts that are implemented in game situations, preparing athletes for NCAA recruiting. Enrollment will be limited and spots fill up quickly.
