#### Amy Weaver, head coach

As head coach for Messiah College, Coach Weaver holds a long line of experience and 23-year tradition with the College. She attended Messiah, playing for four years as a starter in center field. Graduating in 1991, she earned first-team MAC honors. She began assistant coaching in 1993 and took over as head coach in 1997. Weaver has also conducted pitching clinics in Pennsylvania and Maryland. She was named MAC coach of the year four times and earned the NCAA East Region coach of the year honor three times, as well as NCAA Div. III National coach of the year in 2009.

### DIRECTIONS TO MESSIAH

**Southbound on U.S. 15:** Travel approximately 3.5 miles beyond the PA Turnpike interchange and take the Lisburn Road exit. At the light at the bottom of the ramp, turn left onto Lisburn Road. Follow Lisburn through the next traffic light and up to the stop sign at the top of the hill. Continue straight on Lisburn and turn right onto Grantham Road at the bottom of the hill. Follow Grantham Road straight ahead to the stop sign at the main entrance to the College.

**Northbound on U.S. 15:** Travel approximately 4.0 miles beyond the PA 74 North intersection near Dillsburg to the Lisburn Road exit. At the bottom of the ramp, turn right onto Lisburn Road. Follow Lisburn to the stop sign at the top of the hill. Continue straight on Lisburn and turn right onto Grantham Road at the bottom of the hill. Follow Grantham Road straight ahead to the stop sign at the main entrance to the College.
