**2012 RESIDENT CAMP INFO SHEET**  
(Commuters)



**Dates:** Sunday-Thursday, July 22-26

**What To Bring:**

1. Bring a water bottle to take to field sessions. We provide water, but not cups.
2. Footwear: Molded cleats or turf shoes for the grass; indoor soccer shoes or sneakers for the turf.
3. Sunscreen
4. Swimsuit; swimming is optional, but available everyday.
5. Bring an extra set of clothes in case you get one set too dirty to wear.
6. Do not bring a soccer ball; we use our own.
7. A backpack or small athletic bag to carry items between field sessions and the dorm, dining room, etc.

**Thursday, July 26 – Camp Closing Details:**

Camp will end with a short closing program at 11:30 AM Thursday. Parents are encouraged to attend.

**Other Notes:**

1. End of Day Pick-Up: Commuters are picked up at the white tent next to the Softball Field (same as registration) at 8:35 p.m. each evening. If it is raining and the camp has moved indoors the commuters should be picked up at Hostetter Chapel (the old Grantham Church located on campus).
2. Final Payment is due at Registration. All checks should be made payable to “Falcon Soccer Academy.”
3. Commuting Campers are expected to be in one of four places during camp: fields, dining room, pool, or dorm complex.
4. Meals: Commuters eat breakfast at home, but eat lunch and dinner on campus.
5. Free Time: There is some free time during the day, and commuters must go to the dorm with the rest of camp. They can either relax in the lounge or join resident campers in their dorm rooms.
6. Spending Money: Campers may want to bring some extra money for a camp store open in the afternoon located in the dorm lounge.
7. Campers who drive themselves to campus are not allowed to drive their car at all during the day.
8. A certified athletic trainer will be present at Registration to handle any questions or issues.
9. Minor injuries will be treated on site by the athletic trainer. If an injury is sustained requiring more extensive medical care, parents will be notified.
10. Monitoring Dorms: Dorms are monitored during the afternoons and evenings when commuter campers are in the dorm.
11. Bullying: Campers will be immediately disciplined for bullying including but not limited to:  
-Sit out session/game      -Call to parents      -Dismissed from camp with no refund
12. Cancellations: If you have to cancel for any reason, please let us know immediately as there are often people on the waiting list. The \$30 deposit is non-refundable.
