

MESSIAH FALCON SOCCER ACADEMY 2012 RESIDENT CAMP INFO SHEET



Dates: Sunday-Thursday, July 22-26

What To Bring:

1. Bring a water bottle to take to field sessions. We provide water, but not cups.
2. Footwear: Molded cleats or turf shoes for the grass; indoor soccer shoes or sneakers for turf.
3. Sunscreen
4. Swimsuit; swimming is optional, but available everyday.
5. Bring enough shorts, shirts, and socks for the week.
6. Do not bring a soccer ball; we use our own.
7. Each dorm resident will be provided with a towel, sheets, pillow, and a blanket.
8. A backpack or small athletic bag to carry items between field sessions and the dorm, dining room, etc.
9. It is not a problem for campers to bring video games/dvd player as they provide something to do during down times in the day.

Sunday, July 22 – Registration Details:

Sunday Schedule:

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| 12:00-2:00 | Camper Registration @ Jordan Science Center / Move Into Dorm Room |
| 2:30 | Campers at field, dressed to play, for 1 st session |
| 4:45 | 1 st meal at camp |

*Registration location (Jordan Science Center) is adjacent to the dorm complex.

*Because of the large volume of campers expected, it is suggested that you consider arriving on the early end of the registration time window.

Thursday, July 26 – Camp Closing Details:

Camp will end with a short closing program at 11:30 AM Thursday. Parents are encouraged to attend. Campers will by that time already have cleaned their rooms, packed their bags, and turned in their keys, so that by the time camp is over, you need only to go to your son's dorm room, pick up his things, and leave. If you choose to, you may pick up your son's belongings sometimes between 9:30-11:30 AM that morning while your son is at his last field session, and then be able to leave directly from the soccer field parking lot after the closing ceremony.

Other Notes:

1. Final Payment is due at Registration. All checks should be made payable to "Falcon Soccer Academy."
2. Each camper will be issued a room key and meal card, both of which will be placed on a lanyard for convenience during the week. It is important for you to note that keys not turned in at the end of the week will be charged back to the camper at the rate of \$75. Campers will be constantly reminded to be careful as part of a group effort to keep the situation as positive as possible.
3. Roommates: We make every attempt to pair you with the roommate of your choice. In some cases, two people request the same roommate, and when that happens, we are always able to at least put the campers involved in the rooms right next to each other. We will make every effort to accommodate requests, but we WILL NOT make changes to the rooming list within the last 2 weeks before the start of camp, and we will not make changes on registration day.
4. Spending Money: A small amount of spending money for the week should be fine. Campers may want to bring some extra money for a camp store in the afternoon and pizza in the evening.
5. Visitors to the dorm, other than parents, are strictly prohibited.
6. Resident campers must remain on campus at all times during the camp week.

7. Resident campers who drive themselves to campus are not allowed to drive their car at all during the week, on or off campus.
8. A certified athletic trainer will be present at Registration to handle any questions or issues.
9. Minor injuries will be treated on site by the athletic trainer. If an injury is sustained requiring more extensive medical care, parents will be notified. If an injury is sustained that keeps a camper out of two consecutive field sessions, parents will be notified so a decision on whether the camper should be sent home early can be made.
10. Monitoring Dorms: We are very careful in monitoring campers in their dorm rooms. We have 2-4 Coaches stay on each floor during camp and hold floor meetings in the evening. Dorms are also monitored during the afternoons and evenings when campers are in the dorm.
11. Dorm Floors: Dorm Floors are separated by grade (ex. 8th Graders do not room near 12th Graders)
12. Dorm Rooms: Campers should expect to have to keep their rooms and floors clean and in order, and their behavior in the dorms appropriate. Failure in these areas is grounds for dismissal from camp. Campers will also be held financially responsible for any physical damage done to the dorm. We have little tolerance for camper misuse of the dorm rooms & will dismiss campers with no refund for any kind of disruptive behavior.
13. Bullying: Campers will be immediately disciplined for bullying including but not limited to:
 - Sit out session/game
 - Call to parents
 - Dismissed from camp with no refund
14. Cancellations: If you have to cancel for any reason, please let us know immediately as there are often people on the waiting list. The \$30 deposit is non-refundable.
