As a student organization for the Human Development and Family Science Department, MCCFR strives to provide opportunities for students in three areas: professional development; social networking; and service-based activities.



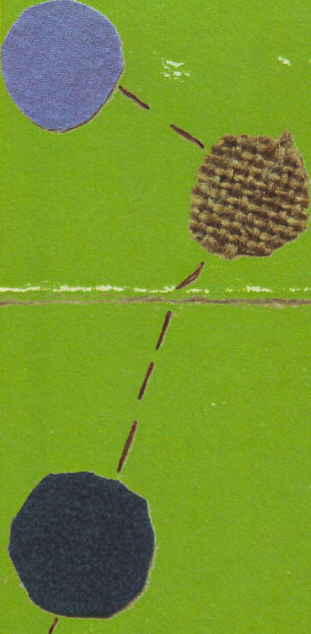
How can students join MCCFR?

MCCFR wants to help students maximize their educational experience at Messiah College by helping them to take what they learn in the classroom and apply it to real life and professional settings.

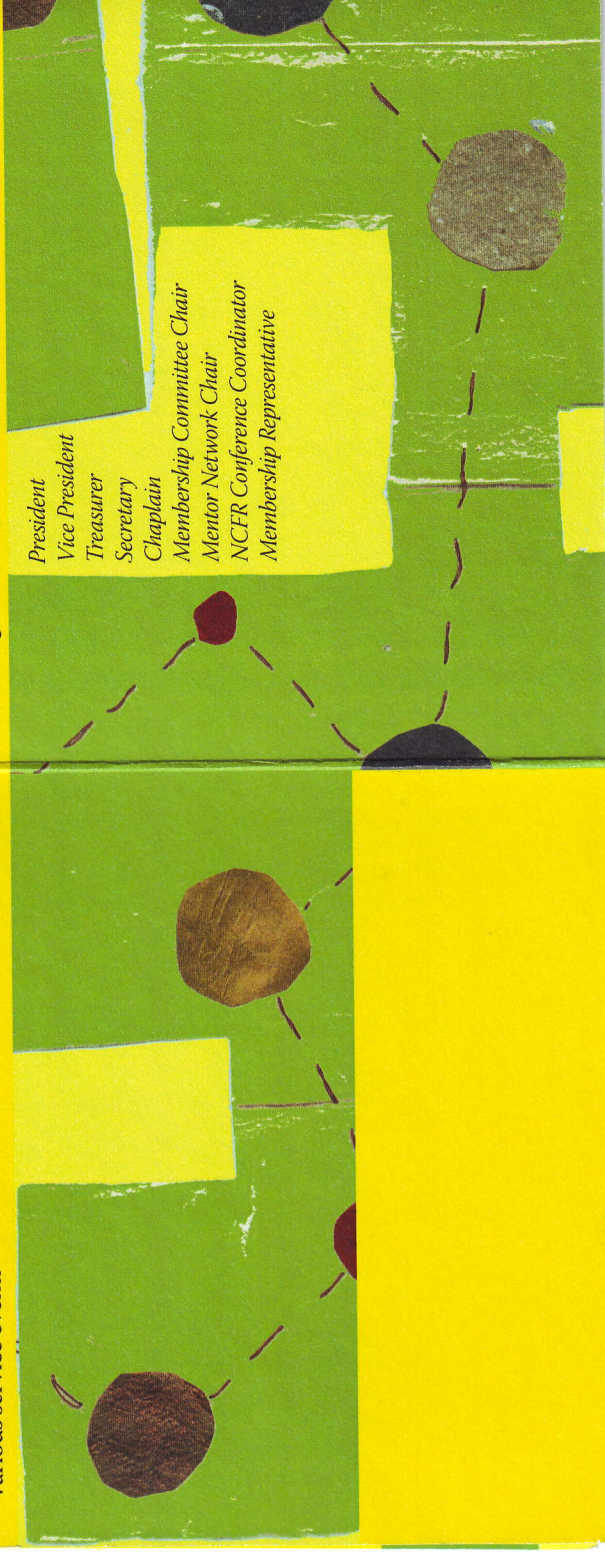
MCCFR sponsors a variety of events, including:
