RESPONSIBILITIES: The successful candidate will teach 12 hours per semester in the Criminal Justice and Criminology Department. Teaching may involve evenings, weekends, online courses, and off-campus. Must advise and be able to work with and be sensitive to the educational needs of students from a diverse, non-traditional student population. Faculty will be expected to serve on departmental, school, and college committees, provide services to the department, the school, and the college, as well as participate in appropriate professional and community activities. Faculty will also be expected to engage in professional development. The successful candidate must have the ability to work with and be sensitive to the educational needs of a diverse urban population.

QUALIFICATIONS: **Required:** Minimum education/work experience includes a master's plus six years of experience or JD, PhD, DPA plus four years of experience or a combination of teaching and/or practical experience in the field of corrections and/or related to victims of crime. **Preferred:** 1) Earned Doctorate in social sciences; 2) Ability to teach introductory and advanced courses in corrections, victimology, and other courses related to the discipline; 3) Criminal justice work experience in corrections at the local, state or federal level especially related to working with ethnic minorities.
