Both Barto and Shell are full-time faculty members in the graduate counseling program.

Test Scores are Looking Good! As you know, all students in the counseling program are required to take the National Counselor Exam (NCE) before they graduate. We are pleased to announce of our first seven students who took the exam in the spring, six of them passed the exam on their first try. In addition, all of our school counseling students who have taken the Praxis II exam (the required exam for certification of school counselors in Pennsylvania) have passed on their first try.
