Friday, August 19, 2022 - Welcome Week Kickoff / All Student Arrival Day

8:00am - 2:00pm: New Student Check-In, Brubaker Auditorium

All new first-year and transfer students at Messiah University should check in on campus when they arrive for the fall semester. New students and their guests should arrive within their arrival timeslot (please see email from your Admissions Counselor for arrival sign-up details). When you check in, you will receive any student materials you need (such as your student ID, room key, and parking permit), your orientation materials, your Welcome Week t-shirt, and your orientation group number.
