• Education Records are those records directly related to a student and maintained by the university or a party acting for the university. (Examples include: academic transcript, class schedule, account information, financial aid award, chapel attendance record, etc.)

Messiah University participates in the various Title IV Federal Financial Aid Programs (e.g. Stafford and Perkins Loans, PELL Grants, etc.) Regulations from The Department of Education require us to comply with that agency's Family Education Rights and Privacy Act (FERPA).
