

HIED 563: Internship II in Higher Education Learning Agreement

The internship course requires that you develop specific learning goals to guide your internship experience. This learning agreement should be prepared in consultation with your Site Supervisor. This agreement must be completed and submitted to your HIED 563 faculty member by the end of the first week of the semester.

Course Objectives

- 1. Demonstrate the ability to reflect upon professional practice for the purposes of improving one's understanding of and ability to serve within professional contexts.
- 2. Show proficiency in engaging linkages between theory and administrative practice, including but not limited to professionalism, diversity, vocation, and ethics.
- 3. Explore the ways their strengths can improve their practice in higher education.
- 4. Appreciate the importance of networking opportunities for professional advancement, including joining a professional organization and/or participating in a professional conference.

You should have a <u>minimum of two learning goals</u> for this course; these must be linked to your professional development goals and to the four course objectives. List your goals and specific steps you plan to accomplish these goals.
