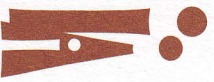


Purpose

The National Council on Family Relations was founded in 1938 to provide a forum for family researchers, educators, and practitioners to share in the development and dissemination of knowledge about families and family relationships, establish professional standards, and work to promote family well-being. NCFR links multi-disciplinary family professionals through its journals, conferences, state affiliate councils, and special interest sections.
