Personal Statement of Purpose: Your 500-1000 word statement should describe your reasons for applying for the Graduate Program in Higher Education at Messiah College, how this graduate program will help you meet your professional and educational goals, and identify an issue in higher education that you will be better equipped to address as a result of your participation in this program.
