

Dietetic Internship

National Match option Preselect option (for Messiah College students only)

Admissions Requirements for National Match:

Submit to Messiah College:

- The completed online application with a \$30 application fee (waived for Messiah College graduates)
- The original/official DPD verification statement indicating that you successfully completed Didactic Program in Dietetics Requirements
- Final official transcript showing degree awarded and conferral date, and transcripts from other schools at which DPD course were taken
- Register with D&D Digital for Spring 2018 Internship Matching

Submit directly to Dietetic Internship Centralize Application System (DICAS):

Application to the Messiah College dietetic internship requires completion of Bachelor's or Master's degree and a
minimum cumulative 3.0 GPA, and anticipated completion of an ACEND-accredited Didactic Program in Dietetics
(DPD) with a minimum cumulative 3.0 GPA

To verify these things submit:

- 1. Official transcripts from all colleges or universities attended
- 2. An intent to complete form or verification statement from your DPD Director verifying completion or anticipated completion of DPD courses and a degree
- Personal Statement of Purpose. Your 1000 word statement should address the following:
- 1. Why do you want to enter the dietetics profession?
- 2. Discuss experiences that have helped to prepare you for your career.
- 3. Why are you interested in completing a dietetic internship at Messiah College?
- 4. What are your short and long term goals?
- 5. What are your strengths and weaknesses or areas needing improvement?
- 6. What other information do you consider important for the selection decision?
- Three letters of recommendation (at least one must be from a volunteer or work supervisor and at least one should be from a college faculty member). The standard DICAS recommendation will be used
- Completion of at least 400 hours of work or volunteer experienced in the past 3 years, including a minimum of 200 hours related of nutrition and dietetics such as nutrition education, food production, or as s dietary aid. Preference will be given to applicants with experience in two or more of the following three areas: medical nutrition, community nutrition or food service.

Admissions Requirements for Preselect Option (Messiah College students only):

- Completion (or anticipated completion) of Bachelor's degree from Messiah College
- Official transcripts indicating a Bachelor's or Master's degree earned where DPD courses were taken
- Anticipated completion of ACEND Didactic Program in Dietetics (DPD) at Messiah College with a minimum of DPD GPA of 3.3 (and no grade less than a C in DPD courses), as well as a cumulative GPA of 3.0 or higher
- Completed Messiah College graduate online application
- Personal Statement of Purpose (see requirement above)
- Three letters of recommendation (at least one must be from a volunteer or work supervisor and at least one should be from a college faculty member). Applicants can invite references to complete an online recommendation form
- Completion of at least 400 hours of work or volunteer experienced (see requirement above)
- The original/official DPD verification statement indicating that you successfully completed the DPD requirements (if you are a current senior, this form will be completed by the Dept of Nutrition and Dietetics and mailed to you in June)
