Semester-long Programs

- Messiah tuition, room, board
- Off-campus fee (\$0, \$1,350, or \$1,910)
- Additional expenses: visas, flights, immunizations, local travel
- Scholarships available

Cross-Cultural Programs

- Messiah tuition (part of spring tuition)
- Course fees: \$3,000-\$5,000
- Flights and meals included
