- 1. A project proposal of about 200-300 words must be attached to this form.
- 2. Project must be of graduate level quality;
- 3. Project must reflect the methodological, theoretical, and substantive expectations for scholarship in the project area;
- 4. Project must be two semesters and total 4 to 6 credit hours;
- 5. Project may begin during the junior year;
- 6. Project must be approved by the Honors Program Director and faculty supervisor during the semester preceding the start of the project;
- 7. Project must culminate with some type of public dissemination, such as a thesis defense, presentation, demonstration, or performance.

SENIOR PROJECT

Department Honors

All majors have the option to apply to their department for Department Honors. If approved, Department Honors will also satisfy the CHP senior project requirement. Course numbers are the prefixes for your major and 497/498 (e.g. APHS497/APHS498). 4-6 credits over two semesters. Credits must be registered with a hard-copy credit registration form. "Department Honors" is noted on diplomas.

(or) Department Project

Some STEM majors have the option of using major courses as their CHP senior project requirement (e.g. BIOL393/BIOL422, CHEM393/ CHEM422, CIS411/CIS412, ENGR415, 300 level MATH/MATH494, PHYS391/ PHYS425). 4-6 credits over two semesters. Credit registration is automatic when courses are registered online.

(or) Honors Project

All majors have the option to pursue an honors project of particular interest to them (it does not have to be related to their major). Course numbers are HONR498/HONR499. 4-6 credits over two semesters. Credits must be registered with a hard-copy credit registration form.

<u>SENIOR</u> SEMINAR

All majors have the option of taking a single senior seminar to fulfill their senior project requirement.

Two senior seminars are offered every fall semester, and one is offered every spring semester. Course number HONR497 online registration (3 credit course)
