**What is Engineering Village?** Engineering Village is actually two large databases in one: Compendex and Referex. **Compendex** is a comprehensive bibliographic database of scientific and technical engineering research, covering all engineering disciplines. It includes millions of bibliographic citations and abstracts from thousands of engineering journals and conference proceedings. **Referex** is a collection of online engineering handbooks. You can search one or both of these databases at the same time.

**How to access Engineering Village:** Go to Messiah Library Homepage, Select Find Articles/Databases, Select Engineering, Select Engineering Village.

**How do I access articles?:** Follow the steps given under “Availability/Navigation”.

| Select which <b>Database</b> to Search              | <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Select Compendex and/or Referex. Both databases are selected by default.</li><li>• To search just journal articles and conference proceedings, select just <b>Compendex</b>.</li><li>• To search just online reference handbooks, select just <b>Referex</b>.</li></ul> |
| Search <b>keywords</b>                              | <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Type keyword(s)</li><li>• Select keyword in the drop down box (default is keyword)</li><li>• Submit Search</li></ul>  |
| Search within specified <b>fields</b> such as title | <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Select field search box and pick keyword, author, title, or publisher</li><li>• Type keyword</li><li>• Submit Search</li></ul>  |
| <b>Limits</b>                                       | <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Select limit by drop boxes:<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>○ Document Type</li><li>○ Language</li><li>○ Dates</li></ul></li><li>• Select Sort by</li></ul>  |

| <p>Search <b>subject headings</b><br/> <i>Subject headings are controlled vocabulary words, or 'tags' assigned by experts. Using these subject words will often give you better results than just regular keywords.</i></p> | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Go to <b>Thesaurus</b> tab</li> <li>• Type in keyword</li> <li>• Find out what are the 'best' terms to use for that topic (subjects)</li> <li>• Select term checkbox</li> <li>• Search for more subject words</li> <li>• Submit search</li> </ul>   |
| <p><b>Refine Results</b></p>  | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• After search, narrow results by checking boxes on the right side <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ Author, and affiliation</li> <li>○ Subject words</li> <li>○ Classification Codes</li> <li>○ Country</li> <li>○ Document Type</li> <li>○ Language</li> <li>○ Year</li> <li>○ Journal Title</li> <li>○ Publisher</li> </ul> </li> </ul> |

| <p><b>Display</b> records or full-text</p> | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Select Abstract, Full text or Article Linker as appropriate</li> </ul>   |
| <p><b>Availability</b></p>                 | <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Determine if the item is a journal article or book or conference proceeding.</li> <li>2. Open Full Text or Article Linker icon if available.</li> <li>3. Journal Article: If not available, or if the link does not work, search the <b>Periodicals List</b> by <i>journal title</i> (not article title) to determine if the journal is full-text in another online database or in the print collection</li> <li>4. Book: If not available, or if link does not work, search the library catalog.</li> <li>5. If we do not have the item (after completing steps 2-4), you can request it through Interlibrary loan (Go to ILLIAD)</li> </ol> |
| <p><b>Refworks</b></p>                     | <p>Select record(s).<br/> Select Download button at the top.<br/> Select Refworks direct export.</p>  |
