“Flex Dollars” – These dollars are added to each debit account for use in any dining facility. Balances do not carry over at the end of the semester.
“ala Cart” – These dollars do not transfer and are forfeited at the end of the semester.

Messiah College Dining Services hereby agrees to provide meals to the above named student in accordance with the meal plan purchased and with the following terms and conditions. Questions about meal plan type should be addressed to Dining Services (717-691-6008) or at www.messiah.edu/dining. Questions about meal plan account status, should be addressed to the Falcon Services Office (717-766-2511, Ext. 6052).

- I. **Agreement Duration:** The duration of this agreement shall be for the **2009-10 academic year** and shall not be abbreviated or adjusted except as specified in Sections IV and V below.
- II. **Eligibility:** Students living in traditional residences are required to purchase a traditional meal plan based on your academic standing as outlined in the meal plan descriptions on the Dining Services web site. Apartments or off-campus students may purchase any of the meal plans listed above. The College and the student are obligated under this agreement upon the student's admission and enrollment in the college. Use of meal plan by the student ratifies this agreement.
- III. **Obligations:**
 - A. Messiah College agrees to admit the student to the dining hall each time the student presents her or his meal card when the customer has purchased a **“Without Limits Ultra”, “210 Meals/200 Flex”, “175 Meals/200 Flex Plan”, “125 Meal/250 Flex Plan”, or a “75 Meal /550 Flex Plan”**. The College agrees to provide these meals at the Nelson Dining Room or at an announced temporary facility during the established meal hours while the College is officially in session. For specific meal plan options and eligibility see www.messiah.edu/dining/2009-10mealplans before selecting a meal plan.
 - B. The student must present a functional College identification card to the Lottie Nelson Dining Room cashier in order to be admitted to a meal. Furthermore, the student agrees to respect the established Dining Services regulations as published on the Dining Services web site at www.messiah.edu/dining/2009-10 mealplans.
- IV. **Agreement Cancellation:** Cancellation of this agreement releases both the student and the college from the obligation of further performance. Upon cancellation, the student will receive a pro-rated refund of his/her payment based upon meal services received prior to cancellation. This agreement **may not be canceled** except for the following reasons:
 - A. Voluntary or involuntary withdrawal of the student from the College.
 - B. Termination by the College of the student's residential privileges.
 - C. Extreme and unforeseen hardship to the student such as hospitalization away from the College.
 - D. Student enrolls in a curriculum of External Programs for the Spring Semester.
- V. **Agreement Adjustment:** This agreement may be adjusted (but not canceled) for the following reasons:
 - A. Housing change from a traditional residence to an apartment, satellite housing, or off campus. Arrangements for a meal plan adjustment, not cancellation, under this clause must be completed by the student (requires notification from academic advisor) with the Director of Dining Services after the housing change has been approved by the Residence Life Office.
 - B. Participation by the student in student teaching or in practicum study required by the academic major which required the student to be off-campus three or more full business days per week. Arrangements for a meal plan adjustment under this clause must be completed by the student (requires notification from academic advisor) with the Director of Dining Services prior to missing the meals.
- VI. **Non-Performance by College:** Should Messiah College become unable to provide the meals specified herein to the student, the student agrees to accept a pro-rated refund.
- VII. **Entitlement to Services:** Only the student named herein is entitled to goods and services extended under this agreement. Goods and services may not be relayed to the student by an intermediary without the prior consent of the Director of Dining Services, nor may the student permit others to exercise their rights under this agreement.
- VIII. **Meal Plan Sign Up procedures:** Meal plan requests are to be completed in Housebook located on the Messiah College Portal. The directions for completing the Meal Plan Requests are also located on the Portal and on the Dining Services Website. Paper Meal Plan Agreement forms are available and located on the Dining Services website.
- IX. **Meal Plan Changes/Adjustments for the 2009-10 Academic Year:** Meal Plan Changes will be accepted through Sept 4th 2009 without a service fee. Starting Sept 5th through Sept 11th, meal plan changes will be accepted with a \$50.00 fee. No Meal Plan changes will be accepted after Sept 11th. Approved Adjustments to the Meal Plan Agreement will be accepted for the spring semester from Nov. 9th 2009 through Jan 4th 2010 without a service fee. Approved adjustments to the Meal Plan Agreement will be accepted from Jan 5th through Jan 12th with a \$50.00 fee. No Meal Plan Adjustments will be approved after Jan 12th 2010 for the Spring Semester.
