

Do It Yourself Configuration 2014

1. You must have a connection to the internet to download and install the software.
2. **Uninstall any Antivirus software currently on your PC**
 - **(Start → Control Panel → Programs/ Features → Uninstall a program (OR Add/Remove Programs))**
3. Download 'Resnet 2014.exe' from: [ResNet 2014](#) saving it to your PC.
4. After the download is complete, if you are running Windows Vista, 7, or 8, right-click on the file and click on **Run as Administrator** and click **Yes** on the prompt that follows. If you are running Windows XP, simply double click on the file to run it.
5. You will receive a pop-up stating **Are you sure you'd like to install Messiah's Resnet 2014 package?** Click **Yes** to continue.
6. You will see files extracting and then a black command window will open. Be sure to follow all prompts from this window to complete the installation process.
 - This will install Firefox 30.0, Microsoft Silverlight, Messiah College applications such as FileSpace, and AVG Free 2014. If any of these are already installed on your PC, the installer will still run and should not cause any issues with the existing programs.
 - AVG Free 2014 is required for ALL students on campus for anti-virus protection. It is the final program to install during this process and may restart your computer once finished.
7. Congratulations!! Your computer is set up for use when you get to campus

When your computer boots up for the first time on Messiah's campus, you will want to connect to the MC-WPA wireless network!

For Windows 8 PCs, you may need to manually select the MC-WPA network from available wireless networks. For older versions of Windows, there will be a bubble that pops up in the right hand corner that says "You must enter more information to connect to the internet". After selecting MC-WPA or clicking on the bubble, you will enter your Messiah username and password (The same that you use for MCsquare). You will be unable to test this until you arrive on campus.
