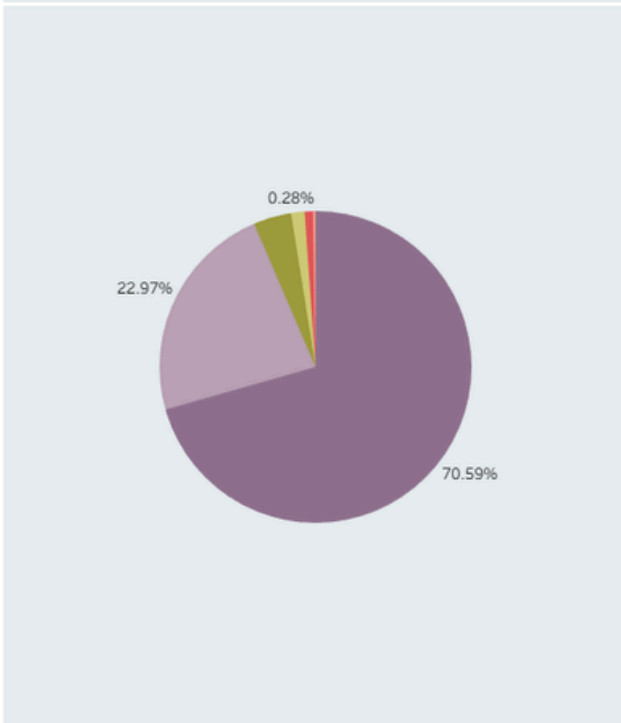

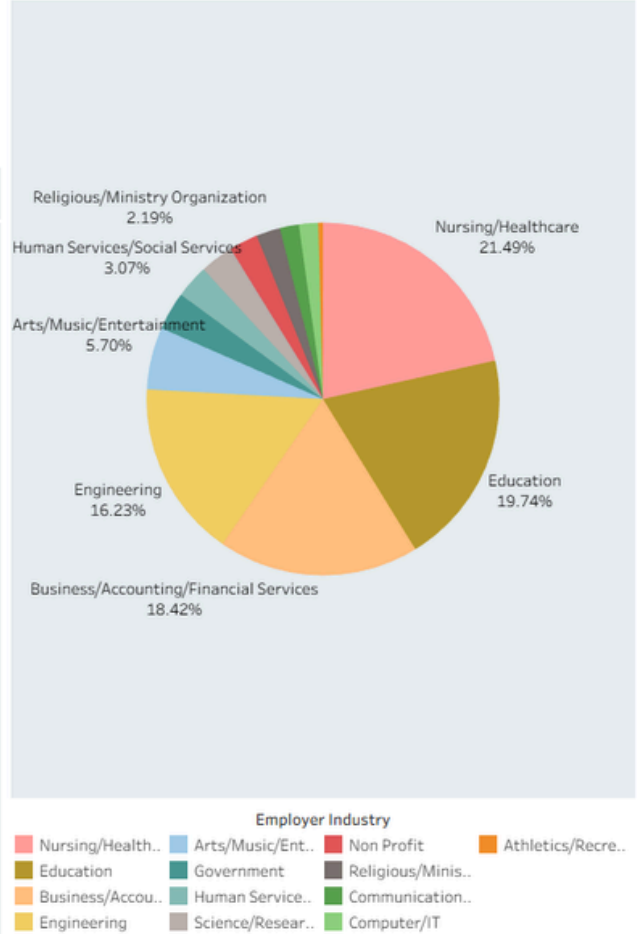

where are Messiah graduates now?

Messiah University career outcomes demonstrate strong post-graduate success, with 70.6% of surveyed students securing full-time employment (30+ hours per week), including postgraduate internships, fellowships, entrepreneurial experiences, freelance, and contract work. Additionally, 23.0% have pursued further education through graduate, professional, or other specialized training programs. A smaller percentage (3.9%) are employed part-time (less than 30 hours per week), while 1.4% are actively seeking employment. A minimal number of graduates (0.3%) are not currently pursuing work or education, and another 0.8% are engaged in missions, volunteer service, or military service. These outcomes are based on a total of 357 students surveyed.

Messiah University graduates have pursued careers across a diverse range of industries. The most common fields include Nursing/Healthcare (21.5%), Education (19.7%), Business/Accounting/Financial Services (18.4%), and Engineering (16.2%). Other significant areas include Arts/Music/Entertainment (5.7%), Government (3.5%), as well as Human Services/Social Services and Science/Research at (3.1%). Graduates have additionally entered Non Profit (2.6%), Religious/Ministry Organizations (2.2%), Communications/Media (1.8%), and Computer/IT (1.8%). Lastly, we have a small percentage (0.4%) of students in Athletics/Recreation/Sports. These outcomes reflect the broad career paths Messiah University students take after graduation.

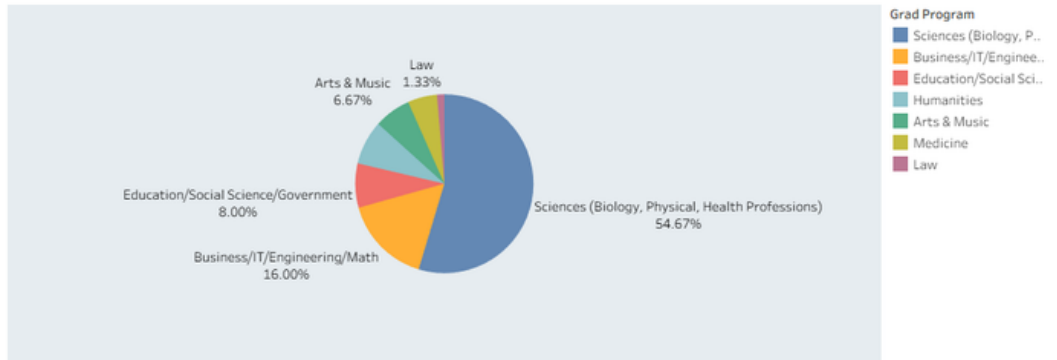

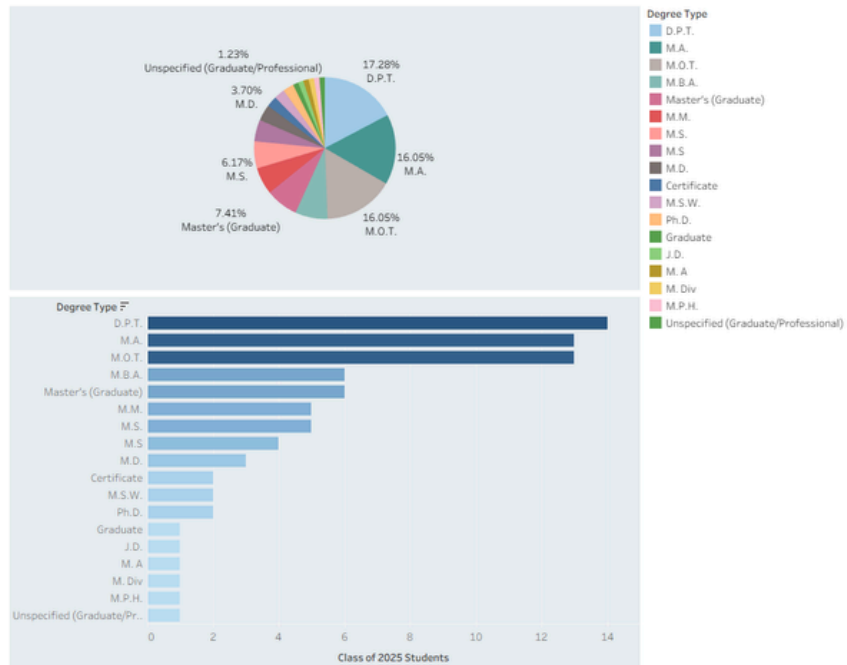

what specific degrees are they pursuing?

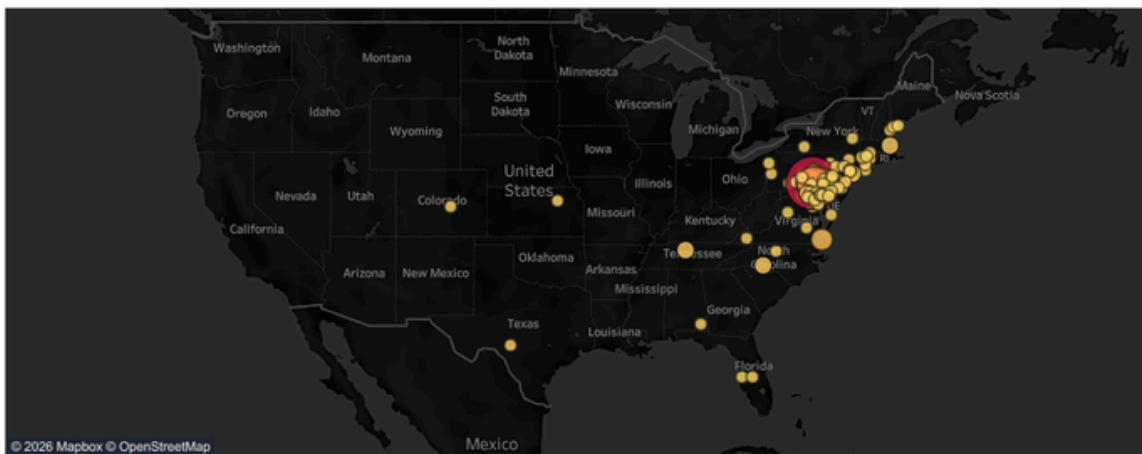
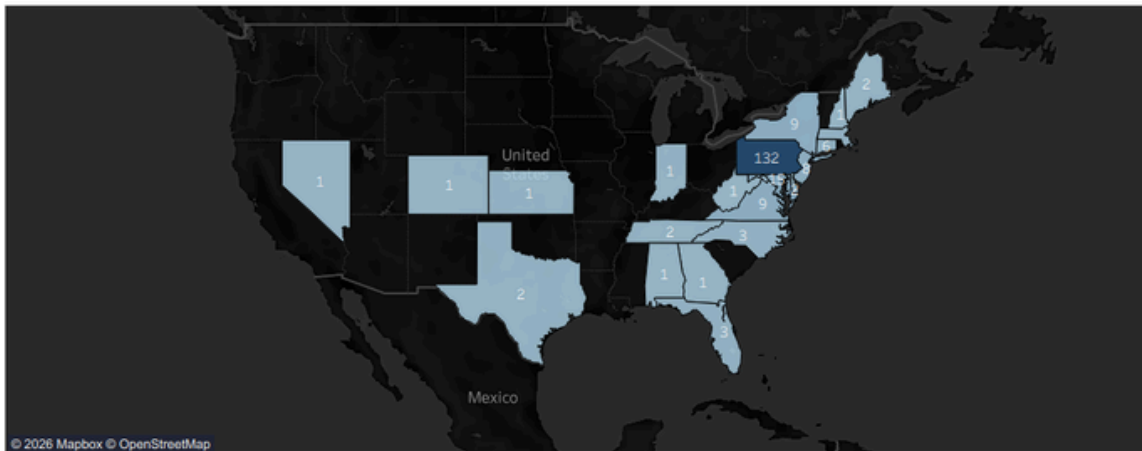


Messiah University graduates pursuing further education enroll in a variety of graduate programs across multiple disciplines. The largest percentage (54.7%) continue their studies in the sciences, including biology, physical sciences, and health professions. Business, IT, engineering, and mathematics represent 16.0% of graduate school placements, followed by education, social science, and government at 8.0%. Humanities account for 8.0%, while arts and music represent 6.7%, medicine 5.3%, and law 1.3%.

Messiah graduates earn advanced degrees in diverse areas, including D.P.T. (17%), M.A. (16%), M.O.T. (16%), M.B.A. (7%), and other specialized degrees such as M.S.W., M.P.H., M.D. and M.M.
