






where are Messiah graduates now?



Messiah University career outcomes demonstrate strong post-graduate success, with 59.6% of surveyed students securing full-time employment (30+ hours per week), including postgraduate internships, fellowships, entrepreneurial experiences, freelance, and contract work. Additionally, 26.6% have pursued further education through graduate, professional, or other specialized training programs. A smaller percentage (7.8%) are employed part-time (less than 30 hours per week), while 5.0% are actively seeking employment. A minimal number of graduates (0.5%) are not currently pursuing work or education, and another 0.5% are engaged in missions, volunteer service, or military service. These outcomes are based on a total of 399 students surveyed.

where are Messiah graduates working?




Messiah University graduates have pursued careers across a diverse range of industries. The most common fields include Education (21.0%), Business/Accounting/Financial Services (20.2%), Nursing/Healthcare (15.9%), and Engineering (13.9%). Other significant areas include Human Services/Social Services (8.7%) and Arts/Music/Entertainment (4.4%). Graduates have also entered Religious/Ministry Organizations (4.0%), Communications/Media (3.6%), and Nonprofits (2.8%). Smaller percentages are represented in Science/Research (2.8%), Computer/IT (2.4%), and Government (0.4%). These outcomes reflect the broad career paths Messiah University students take after graduation.




Messiah alumni graduate schools

Messiah University graduates pursuing further education enroll in a variety of graduate programs across multiple disciplines. The largest percentage (39.0%) continue their studies in the sciences, including biology, physical sciences, and health professions. Education, social sciences, and government represent 16.0% of graduate school placements, followed by business, IT, engineering, and mathematics at 13.0%. Humanities account for 11.0%, while medicine represents 9.0%, and law 5.0%.

Messiah graduates earn advanced degrees in diverse areas, including M.S. (22%), D.P.T. (16%), Ph.D. (16%), and other specialized degrees such as M.S.W., Psy.D., and M.M.
