

INTERNATIONAL STUDENT PROGRAMS

An F-1 student may be authorized by the DSO to participate in a curricular practical training program that is an integral part of an established curriculum. Curricular practical training is defined to be alternative work/study, internship, cooperative education, or any other type of required internship or practicum that is offered by sponsoring employers through cooperative agreements with the school. 8 CFR 214.2(f)(10)(i)

Steps to Apply for CPT:

- 1. Student must **meet with DSO** (Amy Nicols, Lita Godoy or Lyndsay Grimm) to discuss CPT opportunity.
- 2. Student should obtain an **offer letter** for internship and complete Student Information and Employer Information sections of this Request Form.
- 3. Enroll in Internship Course OR Obtain Professor Certification
 - → IF the Internship Course is the relevant course tied to the internship, student must do the following:
 - a) create a Handshake profile at https://messiah.joinhandshake.com/login
 - b) complete the internship approval process with the Career and Professional Development Center **
 - c) enroll in INTE391 or INTE394
 - → IF the internship opportunity is tied to a course other than the Internship Course, then student must obtain signature confirmation from the relevant Professor.
- 4. After student has enrolled in an Internship Course OR the relevant Professor has signed off on the CPT Request Form, **student must return this form to the ISP**Office (or Grad students to Lyndsay Grimm) with a copy of any offer letter.
- A new Form I-20 will be created by the ISP Office, containing Authorization for the student's CPT – STUDENT MAY NOT BEGIN WORK UNTIL THIS NEW FORM I-20 IS CREATED ****
