Student Accompanist Policies

Messiah University, approved Spring 2025

Accompanists for degree recitals and juries/performances on your primary instrument:

- Work-study accompanists can be requested for a degree recital and events
 associated with a student's **primary** instrument/voice lessons. (Non-degree
 recitals or lessons for non-majors do not qualify.) Requests are due the first month
 of class.
- Accompanists should log hours on their timesheet for the time spent <u>practicing with</u> their soloists (up to 1 hour per week), plus up to 2 hours of time total (not weekly) per each soloist for music preparation that takes place.
- In addition, the **soloist** must pay a flat fee for each "event" they use the pianist. Fees are listed below and must be paid in advance by the student soloist.
- Soloists may need to hire a professional pianist for recitals if the difficulty is very high and an appropriate student-accompanist is not available. For many senior recitals, this is recommended.
- It is the responsibility of the pianist to be prepared to play the music at a high level. Pianists should work on music <u>in advance</u> to make sure they are ready in time.

Accompanists for non-degree recitals, secondary lessons, and non-music majors:

- Work-study accompanists are not to be used in these situations.
- Student soloists must acquire their own accompanist (either a student pianist or professional pianist in the community) and work out a fee with them directly.

Work-Study Accompanist Fees

These are flat fees per event, to be paid directly from the soloist to the accompanist **in advance** of the event taking place. Accompanists are not obligated to play for events if they have not been compensated.
