- Personal Statement of Purpose: Your 300-500 word statement should describe your preparations for graduate work, your reasons for applying for this particular graduate program at Messiah University and how this graduate program will help you meet your professional and educational goals
- □ A 15-20 minute recording of the applicant conducting a live performance or rehearsal of a self-prepared ensemble**
 - Applicant needs to conduct with camera facing the conductor showing common meters.
 - Applicant must submit video exhibiting two, contrasting styles
- □ Recorded example of applicant playing in the keys of G major, F major, Eb major, and their relative natural minors * **
 - Scales: two octaves, hands together, ascending and descending
 - Chord Progression: I IV6/4 I V6/5 I; i iv6/4 i v6/5 i
- □ Two letters of recommendations (addressing your professional experience and/or academic performance, excluding relatives) *

□ Access to a performing ensemble in the applied area for use in the capstone requirement * **
