### OVERVIEW

Messiah University is a nationally ranked, private Christian university with a student body of more than 3,200 undergraduate and graduate students located in Mechanicsburg, Pennsylvania, just 12 miles from the state capital, Harrisburg.



- All of Messiah's majors require **experiential learning** (internships, leadership, service learning, off-campus study or research) as a graduation requirement.

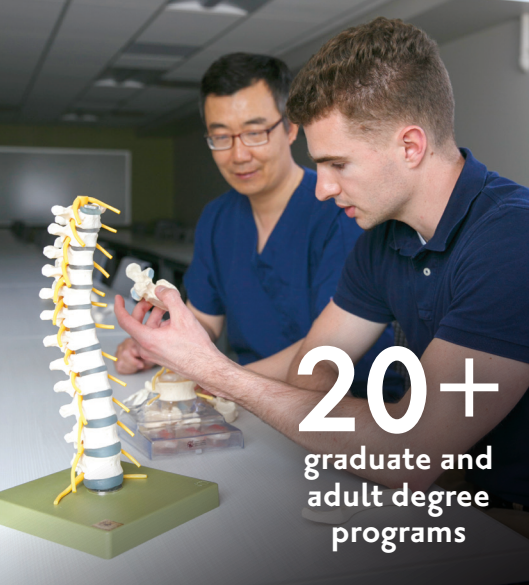

- Messiah's **Oakes Museum of Natural History** provides guided tours, field trips and special events to allow visitors to experience the museum's collections of African and North American animals, birds, eggs and nests; Native American artifacts; rocks and minerals; and seashells.
