• The shifted focus from agriculture to manufacturing affects employment opportunities and growth.



- Population Decline
- Two Different Approaches to Addressing Decline
  - Supporting Hispanic Immigrants
  - A redirected purpose allows small-town communities to use their energy and resources to address challenges.
- Social Capital
  - Builds and sustains community attachment and social efficacy
  - Community attachment sustains individual investment resulting in a positive view of community.
  - Example: Homeowners
  - Social efficacy channels the belief that individuals will bring about public good through action. This response allows for residents to gain autonomy and ownership.
