Class of 2023 First Destination Survey – Executive Summary

ABOUT THE SURVEY

The purpose of the annual First Destination Survey is to capture information on Messiah University's alums' employment and graduate school status within six to nine months of graduation. For the purpose of this survey, the "Class of 2023" is defined as anyone who graduated in December 2022, May 2023, or August 2023.

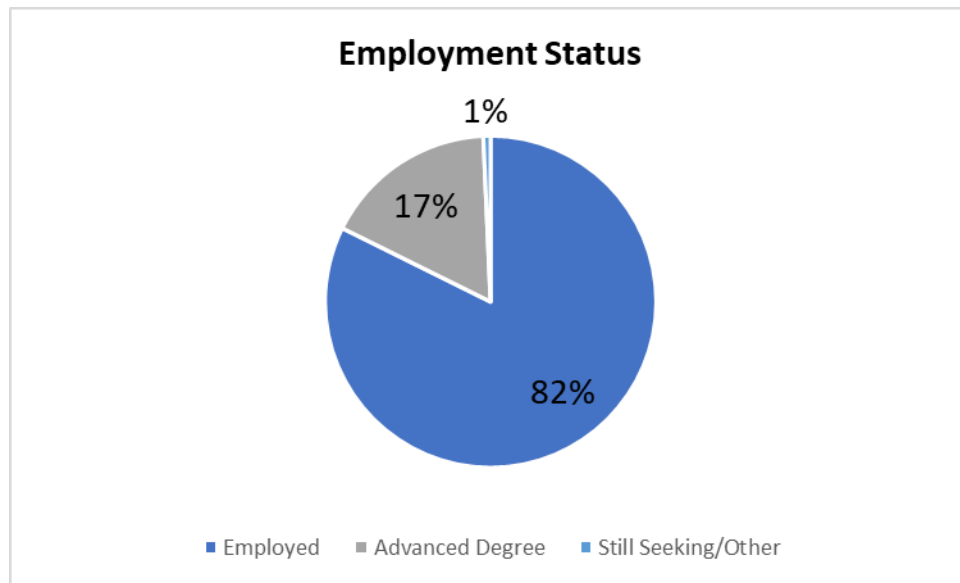
Statistics provided are based on information received through a variety of methods. An electronic survey was distributed in May via email. Graduating seniors who had confirmed their post-graduation plans were asked to complete the survey during the cap and gown distribution in May. Follow-up emails were then sent in October, November, and December to alums who had not yet responded to the survey. In January, individual academic departments were contacted via phone or email, and a request was made to all Messiah University educators for any additional information on graduates whose status remained unknown. Finally, information on non-responders was gathered from updated professional profiles on social media sites such as LinkedIn. It is important to note that the collection process and reporting summary of results adheres to the professional guidelines set forth by NACE (the National Association for Colleges and Employers).

Through this extensive process, we obtained a 77% knowledge rate for the Class of 2023. "Knowledge rate" is defined by NACE as the "percent of graduates for which an institution has reasonable and verifiable information concerning the graduates' post-graduation career activities."

This report aims to provide summary highlights and a breakdown by academic department of the post-graduate activity for the Class of 2023.

GENERAL SUMMARY

Graduates of the Class of 2023 were asked to identify their **primary status** 6 to 9 months after graduation.

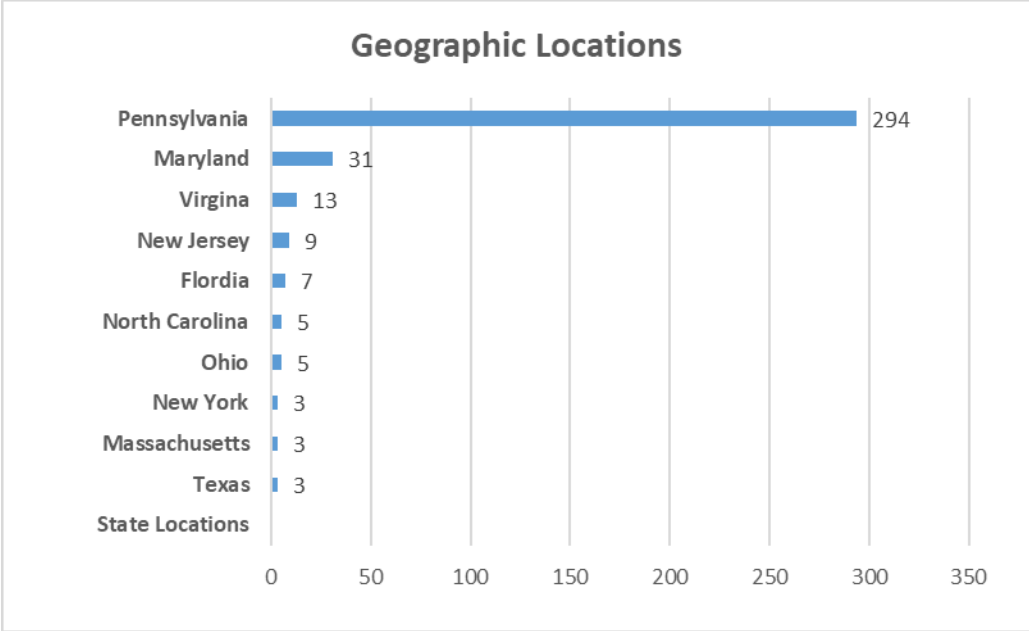


Of the 77% for whom we have verifiable data, 99% report being employed or in a graduate or professional program within 6 to 9 months after graduation (82% secured employment, and 17% indicated graduate or professional school).

The statistics for Messiah University graduates compare favorably to the most recent national averages reported by the National Association of Colleges and Employers (NACE) in their "First Destination for the College Class of 2022" report. (Please note: the national Class of 2023 data from NACE will not be available until the summer of 2024). The following statistics show the national averages for the primary activity of the Class of 2022 as reported by NACE: **64% employment (compared to 82% for Messiah graduates); 19.4% graduate-level programs (compared to 17% for Messiah graduates); and 16.6% seeking (compared to 1% for Messiah graduates).**

GEOGRAPHIC DESTINATIONS

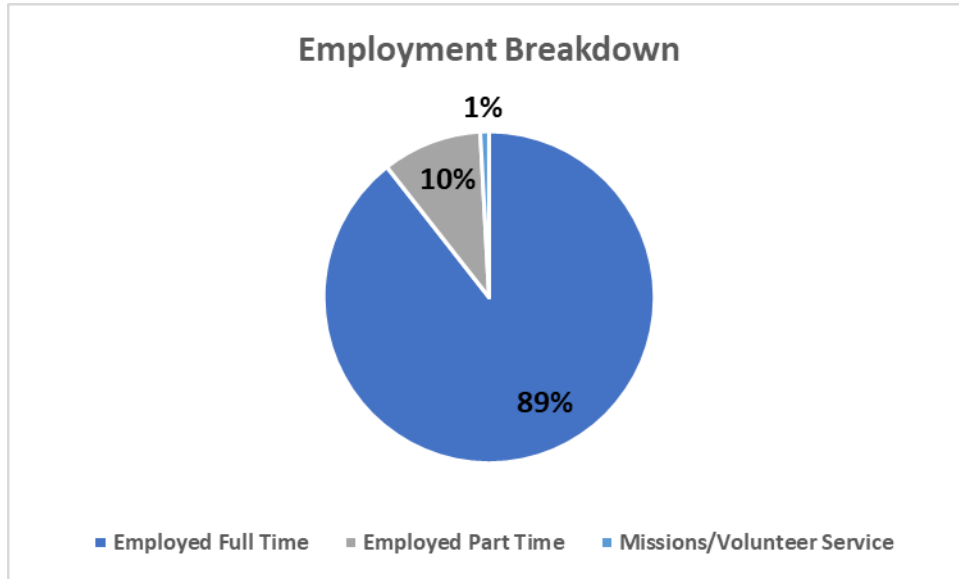
The geographic destinations for the Class of 2023 spanned the United States as well as international locations. In the US, the Mid-Atlantic continues to be the strongest draw for Messiah University graduates, constituting approximately 82% of the graduates.

EMPLOYMENT INFORMATION

82% of the Class of 2023 reported employment as their primary status following graduation. Graduates in full-time work, part-time work, and missions/volunteer service are considered employed for the purpose of this survey. The chart below shows the breakdown of the types of employment for the Class of 2023.



Please note: the following definitions were used:

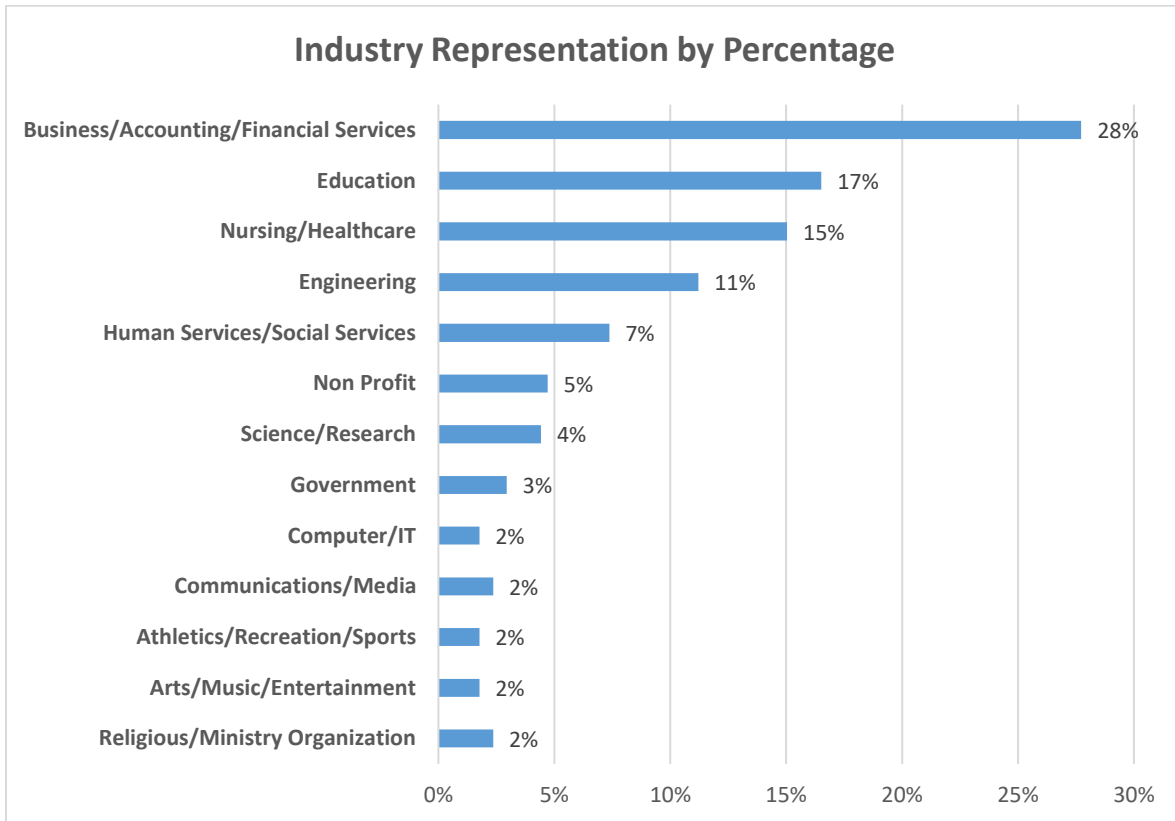
Full-time- 30+ hours/week; includes post-graduate internships, fellowships, entrepreneur experience, freelance, and contract work

Part-time- less than 30 hours/week; includes all activities listed above

Missions/Volunteer Service- includes positions that are unpaid, self-funded, or have a stipend; the military is also included

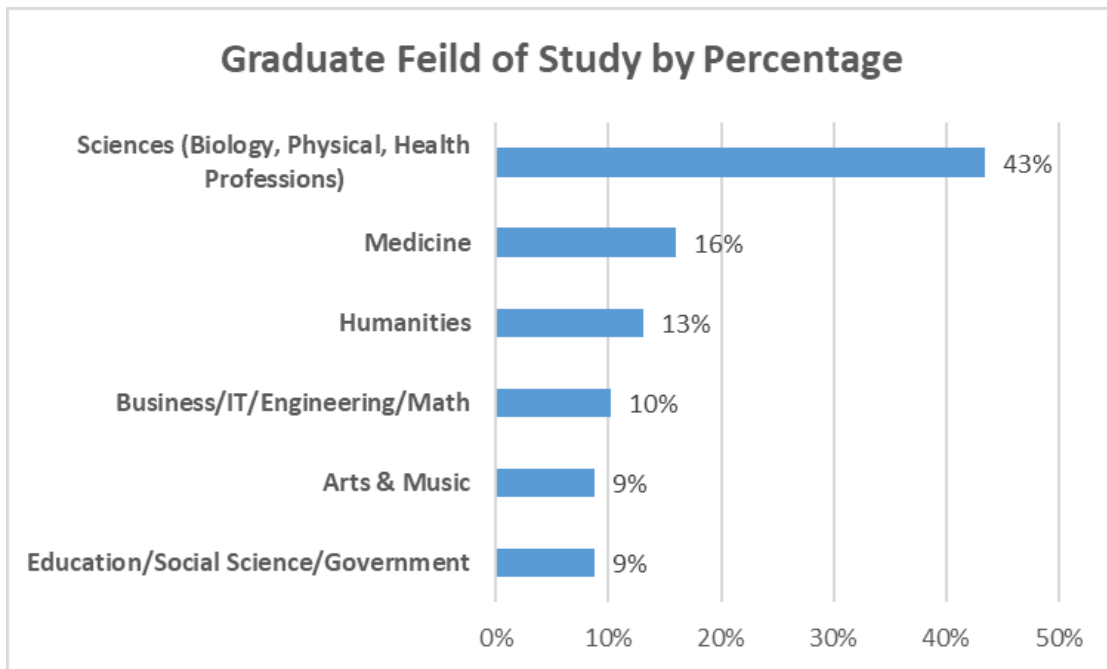
